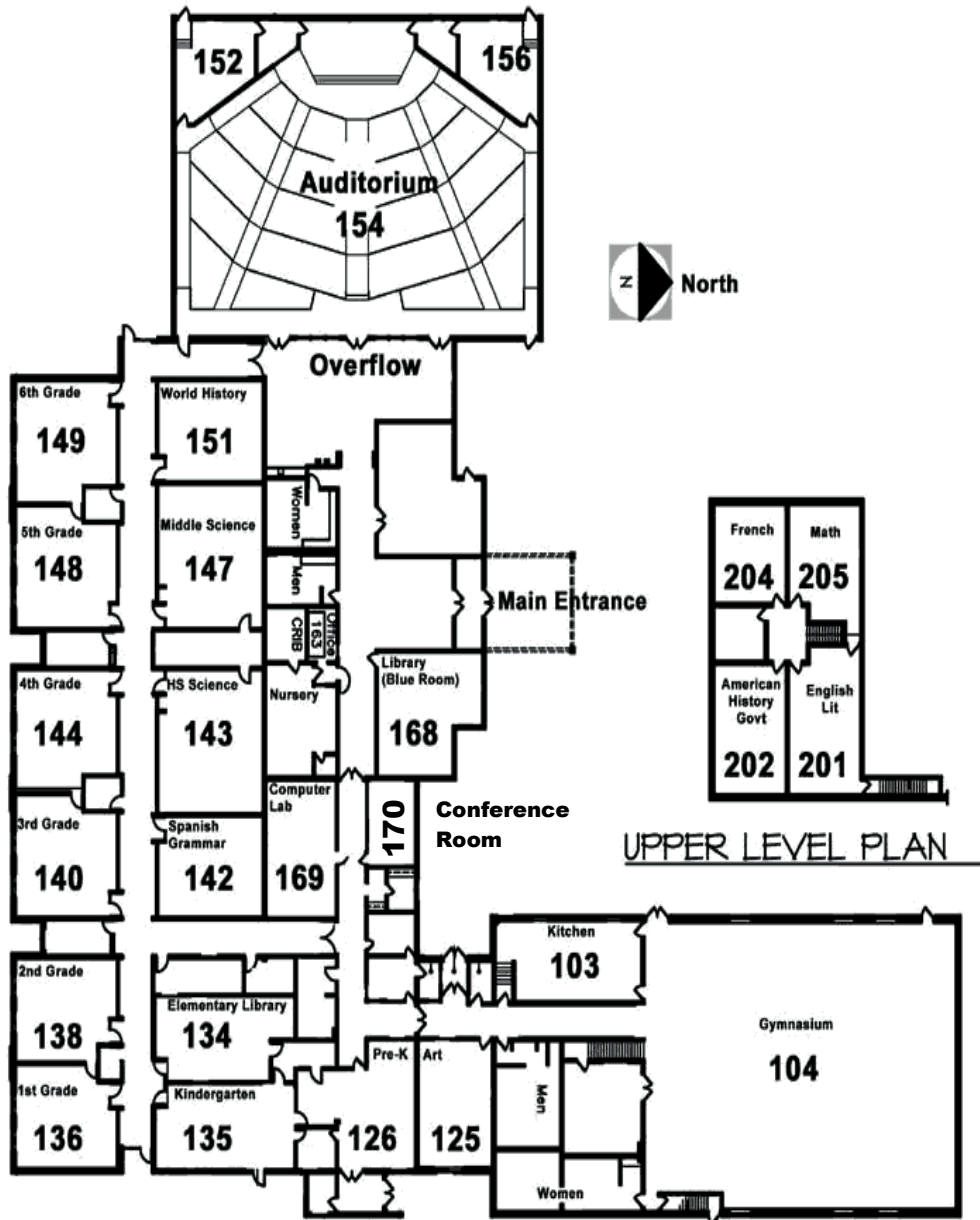


# MAP OF CLASSROOM NUMBERS
